ORDER

The Court informed the parties that it would likely require an evidentiary hearing before it could decide the FTC's Motion for Preliminary Injunction.¹ (Doc. 62). The parties jointly filed their proposed evidentiary hearing structure. (Doc. 65). Upon review, it is hereby

ORDERED:

1. The Court has reserved **September 21, 2022** and **September 22, 2022** for the evidentiary hearing if the parties do not resolve the case at the settlement conference. Each side has one day to present their case.

2. Each side shall file a Witness and Exhibit List no later than **September 7, 2022**. The Court will then issue a further order governing the hearing.
